



SAFETY, HEALTH & ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT

The Chipping Show Committee is committed to the prevention of injury and ill health to our stewards, exhibitors, livestock and members of the public who may be affected by our activities. This will be achieved and maintained through a process of risk management. Risk management systems will be used to identify hazards, make assessments and produce appropriate actions to remove and/or minimise risks in a controlled manner.

People are our key resource and we are committed to the development of our stewards with adequate resourcing in all our operations and functions. We believe that excellent health, safety and environmental standards will contribute to the development of the event and will lead us to the achievement of the highest levels of performance. Accordingly, we shall encourage ideas from all our stewards and drive through initiatives aimed at continuous improvement of our management and operational capabilities. We will work with regard and respect to our fellow stewards, exhibitors, livestock, the public at large and the environment. We will open discussions in the event of accidents, incidents or near misses. We will operate a no blame culture to ensure we learn from such events.

We will ensure that our stewards are informed about this Statement and our Event Management Plan, which details the arrangements for carrying out their responsibilities safely. We will consult with them on its implementation and the individual health, safety and environmental responsibilities allocated to them. The principal operational responsibility for implementing this policy ultimately lies with all levels of the Chipping Show Committee.

We will continuously monitor Health, Safety and Environmental performance by the use of key stewards to ensure that standards are being met, management controls are working and improvements are being made.

I am personally committed to the objective of zero incidents and accidents and to the success of the Chipping Show.
